In the context of sustainable business, the Management of COLOSSOS S.A. (the Company), owner and manager of Amada Colossos 5\* Resort (the Hotel), has established standards for the responsible procurement of products and services, considering environmental, social and ethical factors.

The Company prioritises the procurement of locally or domestically produced products, wherever possible and in accordance with the Hotel’s established quality standards, thus reducing shipping and transportation requirements. The Company explicitly states that the Hotel does not procure endangered or wild species.

Given that the Hotel’s operation is intertwined with the local community and its traditional character, special preference is given to the procurement of products that reflect the nature, history and culture of the region, and these products are showcased in the offered products list of the catering departments.

Equipment for the Hotel is selected based on the criteria of energy and water efficiency as well as the absence of any prohibited refrigerant gases.

One important criterion applied in the procurement of products for the Hotel is the material from which the products are made. Preferred products are those made from recyclable material or material that can be recycled locally. Products that contain substances harmful to the environment e.g. microplastics, banned chemicals (POPs) are avoided.

The production method is another important criterion applied in the selection of products and services procured by the Hotel, giving preference to those produced in a sustainable manner or from sustainable raw materials.

In addition, an important criterion applied in the selection of our Company's suppliers is the absence of any form of exploitation or abuse on the part of our supplier-partners.

The Hotel procures chemicals and single-use plastics only to the extent necessary to ensure its proper operation.

Any renovation or construction works are carried out in a sustainable manner, ensuring the preservation of the local landscape and cultural heritage. Respectively, when selecting plants, priority is given to drought and pest resistant native or endemic species of the region.
